**A PROCLAMATION**

By the Governor

**WHEREAS**, on January 23, 2026, I, Governor Patrick Morrisey, declared a State of Emergency in all 55 Counties of the State of West Virginia, pursuant to West Virginia Code § 15-5-6, because of an imminent and significant winter storm that was expected to pose a threat to the health, safety, welfare, and property of the citizens of West Virginia; and

**WHEREAS**, the significant winter storm related to this proclamation has passed, and weather conditions no longer merit emergency precautions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK MORRISEY**, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Governor of the State of West Virginia, and in view of the foregoing, do hereby **TERMINATE** the January 23, 2026, State of Emergency.
