A PROCLAMATION

By the Governor

WHEREAS, Larry D. Kump was born on January 27, 1948, in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, to Willis "Woody" Theodore Kump and Betty Ann Steinbach; and

WHEREAS, Larry D. Kump graduated from Frostburg State University and Hagerstown Community College earning a degree in political science; and

WHEREAS, Larry D. Kump served the citizens of Berkeley County for nearly ten years, representing the 52nd, 59th, and 94th Districts during the periods of 2010-2014, 2018-2020, and from 2022 until his passing; and

WHEREAS, during his time in the House of Delegates, Larry D. Kump was known for his principled conservatism and witticisms such as "great googly moogly" and "for sure and for certain"; and

WHEREAS, Larry D. Kump was a devoted husband to his wife, Cheryl, and a devoted father to his 13 children, and he has left behind a legacy of family devotion and community service as a High Priest in The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of West Virginia, friends, and associates of Larry D. Kump desire to recognize his dedicated public service to the Great State of West Virginia, and to acknowledge his valuable contributions to the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK MORRISEY, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Governor of the State of West Virginia, do hereby **ORDER** that, in commemoration of the distinguished life and service of West Virginia Delegate Larry D. Kump, the United States and West Virginia State flags displayed at the Capitol Complex in Charleston, West Virginia, and at all State facilities throughout Berkeley County, West Virginia, shall remain at half-staff from noon on March 4, 2026, until sunset on Friday, March 6, 2026, to honor the life and service of Delegate Larry D. Kump.
