**AMENDED LETTER OF INTENT RECEIVED**

March 27, 2014 – Dermatology Centers, Inc., Beaver, Raleigh County, CON File #13-1/4-9986-E, for purchase of an SRT-100 superficial radiotherapy machine to treat certain basal cell and squamous cell carcinomas that are in locations that are not amenable for surgical treatment; capital expenditure: \$232,000.
