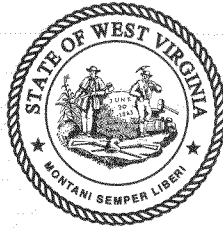

The West Virginia Interactive Wagering Rule sets forth the guidelines for regulating the operation of interactive wagering in WV. Interactive wagering is the wagering of money on the outcome of a game using the Internet. It includes poker and online casino games. The Rule provides regulations that the Commission considers necessary for the implementation of interactive wagering. The Rule requires certain systems to monitor and safeguard the placing of wagers on-site or via mobile applications, thus ensuring only individuals who are 21 years of age or older and are located in the state of West Virginia, may wager.

SUMMARIZE IN A CLEAR AND CONCISE MANNER THE REASONS FOR REQUESTING A SUNSET PROVISION EXTENSION:

The Interactive Wagering Rule is set to expire in 18 months on August 1, 2026. The Lottery is requesting an extension of the sunset date to August 1, 2031, without any amendments pursuant to W. Va. Code §29A-3A-20 (e).

SUMMARIZE IN A CLEAR AND CONCISE MANNER THE OVERALL ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE RULE:

A. ECONOMIC IMPACT ON REVENUES OF STATE GOVERNMENT:
