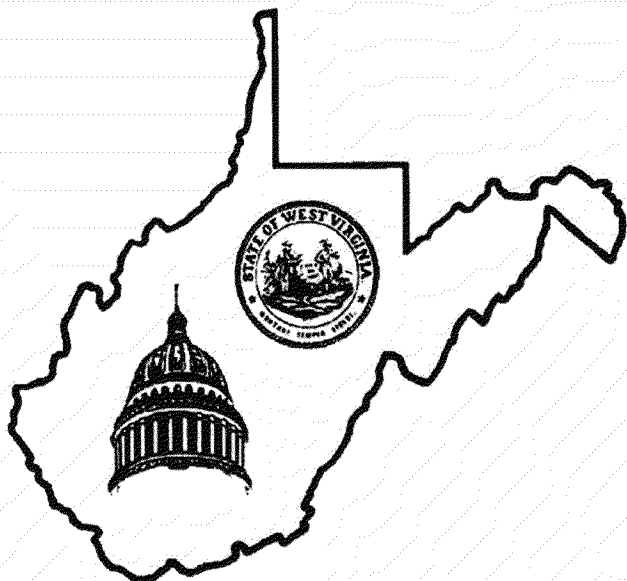

22-005	On November 12, 2021, and November 15, 2021, the Compliance Division of the West Virginia State Tax Commissioner's Office ("the Tax Department" or "the Respondent") issued nine refund denials to the Petitioner, AAA, ("AAA" or "Petitioner"). The Petitioner is a trucking company. These refund denials were issued pursuant to the authority of the State Tax Commissioner, granted to him by the provisions of Chapter 11, Article 10 <i>et seq.</i> of the West Virginia Code. The refund denials stated that the Petitioner did not qualify for an off-highway use refund because the fuel tax was paid in BBB and claimed in an IFTA return in Utah. These nine refund denial letters stated this same reason in each letter. The refund denial letters included the following tax periods: September 30, 2019, for the amount of \$XX; December 31, 2019, for the amount of \$XX; March 31, 2020, for the amount of \$XX; June 30, 2020, for the amount of \$XX; September 30, 2020, for the amount of \$XX; December 31, 2020, for the amount of \$XX; March 31, 2021, for the amount of \$XX; June 30, 2021, for the amount of \$XX; and September 30, 2021, for the amount of \$XX. The Petitioner timely filed its Petition for Appeal with this Tribunal on January 10, 2022. Subsequently, notice of a hearing on the petition was sent to the parties and in accordance with the provisions of West Virginia Code Section 11-10A-10, a hearing was held on August 31, 2023, and October 26, 2023. Thereafter, the parties submitted briefs, with the evidence closed on February 27, 2024, and the matter became ripe for decision at that time.	05/21/2024
23-129	On July 18, 2023, the Auditing Division of the West Virginia State Tax Department (the "Tax Commissioner" or "Respondent") issued an Audit Notice of Assessment against the Petitioner. This assessment was issued pursuant to the authority of the State Tax Commissioner, granted to him by the provisions of Chapter 11, Article 10 <i>et seq.</i> of the West Virginia Code. 23-1354	The Petitioners in this matter are three (3) limited liability companies with commercial property in AAA County, West Virginia (hereafter "property owner"). Specifically, they own and operate natural gas pipelines. In August of 2022, the property owner submitted property tax returns for this property to the AAA County Assessor. Thereafter, by email dated December 13, 2022, the property owner requested that the Assessor consider economic obsolescence when valuing the property. The property owner never received a response to this request from the Assessor. Thereafter, on February 13, 2023, the property owner timely filed an appeal with this Tribunal. Evidentiary hearings were held on October 4, 2023, and October 19, 2023. After the filing of post-hearing briefs, the record was closed on March 1, 2024. On May 16, 2024, in a companion case, the EEE County Assessor moved to reopen the record, a Motion the property owner did not oppose. The Petitioners own royalty interests in natural gas wells located in Brooke County and Ohio County, West Virginia. The State Tax Commissioner appraised the value of the Petitioners' royalty interests, the Brooke County and Ohio County Assessors assessed the property based on the Tax Commissioner's appraisals, and the Petitioners filed the underlying appeal to challenge those assessments. The Petitioners filed a Petition for Appeal with this Tribunal on February 20, 2024. On July 23, 2024, the parties appeared by Videoconference for an Evidentiary Hearing. J. Anthony Edmond Jr., Esq., of Edmond & Baum, PLLC, represented the Petitioners, and Robert B. Wilson, Esq., of the State Tax Department, represented the Tax Commissioner. The matter became ripe for decision on November 11, 2024, when the post-hearing brief filing period ended and the record closed. ADDITIONAL ONE MONTH EXTENSION OF TIME TO PAY Q1 ACUTE CARE
HEALTH CARE PROVIDER TAX**

On April 2, 2025, the Tax Division issued Administrative Notice 2025-01, finding that certain delays in operation of the Directed Payment Program funded by proceeds of the eligible acute care hospital tax may result in potential financial complications for acute care hospital taxpayers. As a result, the Tax Division extended the first quarter due date for payment of the tax by 30 days from April 15, 2025, to May 15, 2025. No extension was provided for filing the quarterly tax return.

On advice of the Commissioner of the Bureau of Medical Services, the Tax Division finds that continued delays in operation of this program will continue to result in potential financial complications for acute care hospital taxpayers. Therefore, the Tax Division authorizes an additional 1 month extension of time to pay the 1st quarter acute care tax payment. The tax payment that would have been due April 15, 2025, and was previously extended to May 15, 2025, is now further extended to June 15, 2025. Penalties and interest on unpaid amounts will not be added or accrue for this additional 1 month period.

As with the previous extension, this is an extension of time to pay. It is NOT an extension of time to file tax returns.

The current tax rate will remain in effect until a revised tax rate is published.
