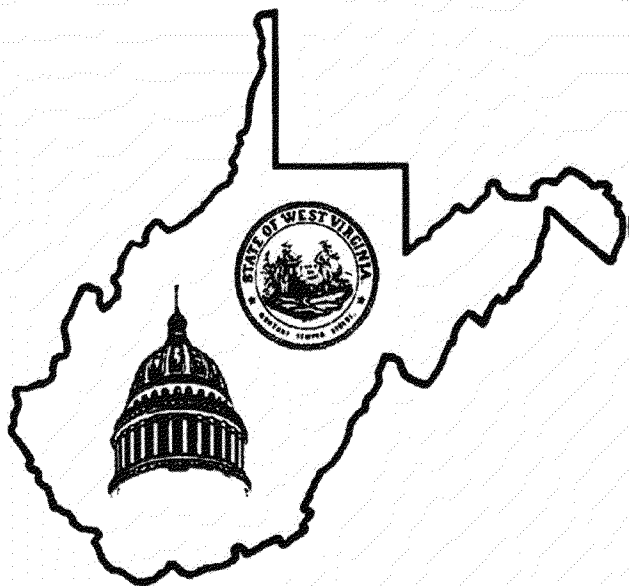

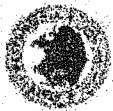

The rule implements a statutory requirement that insurers licensed to sell fire policies in the state must make mine subsidence insurance available to citizens. The reinsurance program administered by BRIM under this rule is authorized by W.Va. Code §33-30-15. The rule establishes the processes under which the program operates, the rates for the coverage, the policy forms, and the reinsurance agreement form that insurers must execute to participate in this required program.

SUMMARIZE IN A CLEAR AND CONCISE MANNER THE REASONS FOR REQUESTING A SUNSET PROVISION EXTENSION:

The rule is necessary to effectuate the provisions of Article 30, related to mine subsidence insurance.

SUMMARIZE IN A CLEAR AND CONCISE MANNER THE OVERALL ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE RULE:

A. ECONOMIC IMPACT ON REVENUES OF STATE GOVERNMENT:

BRIM, in consultation with its actuary, determines the rate charged for mine subsidence insurance. The current rule decreased premiums because previous rates exceeded projected mine subsidence losses. This rate reduction created a \$850,000 decrease in state revenues but increased savings to the consumer. The proposed sunset extension maintains rates because they are set at an amount that adequately funds the program.
