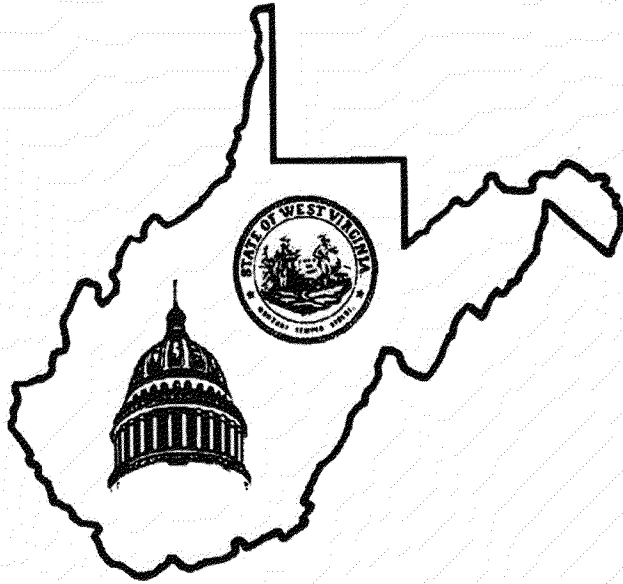

47 CSR 9B (New Rule): This is a new legislative rule that establishes schedules of fees for carbon dioxide capture and sequestration authorized by underground injection control permits issued by DWWWM. The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has delegated primary enforcement authority for all facets of the Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program to WVDEP through the approval of the primacy for Class VI wells. WVDEP's UIC Program is primarily supported by Special Revenue (fees). Currently this program has no regulatory structure to charge Carbon Dioxide Sequestration UIC fees but has applications to be processed. The Agency is unable to fulfill its obligations under primacy, as WVDEP cannot process permit applications until relevant fees are paid. Hence it is imperative that this rule be promulgated.
