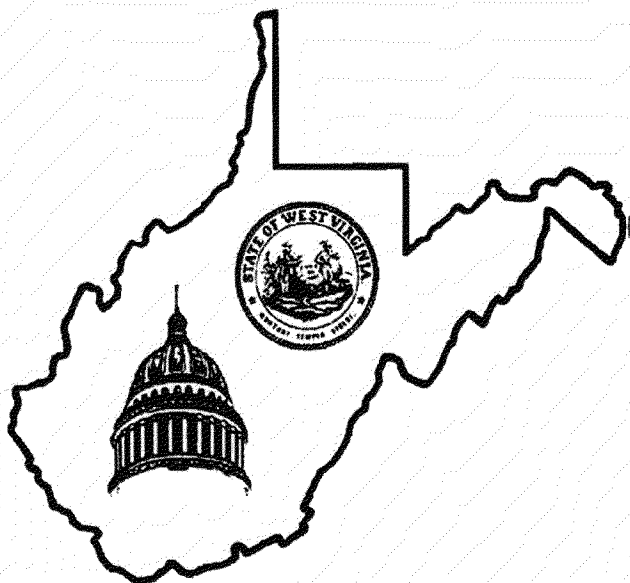

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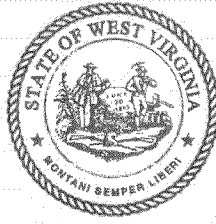

Ms. Lewis:

Please be advised that the West Virginia Legislature passed Senate Bill 856 during the 2025 regular legislative session. This bill became effective on July 11, 2025, and specifically repealed W. Va. Code §§ 33-20B-6 and 33-20B-8. Included in the repeal was a provision in W. Va. Code § 33-20B-6, which required the commissioner to promulgate legislative establishing procedures for the fair and appropriate evaluation and determination of the past loss experience and prospective or projected loss experience of medical malpractice insurers.

The Insurance Commissioner promulgated two legislative rules regarding the statutory rulemaking mandate: 114 CSR 22, *Medical Malpractice Annual Reporting Requirements*, and 114 CSR 23, *Medical Malpractice Loss Experience and Loss Expense Annual Reporting Requirements*. Because the enabling legislation requiring the rules was repealed, and this agency no longer has authority or need for the rules, I am asking the Secretary of State to repeal the rules effective immediately.

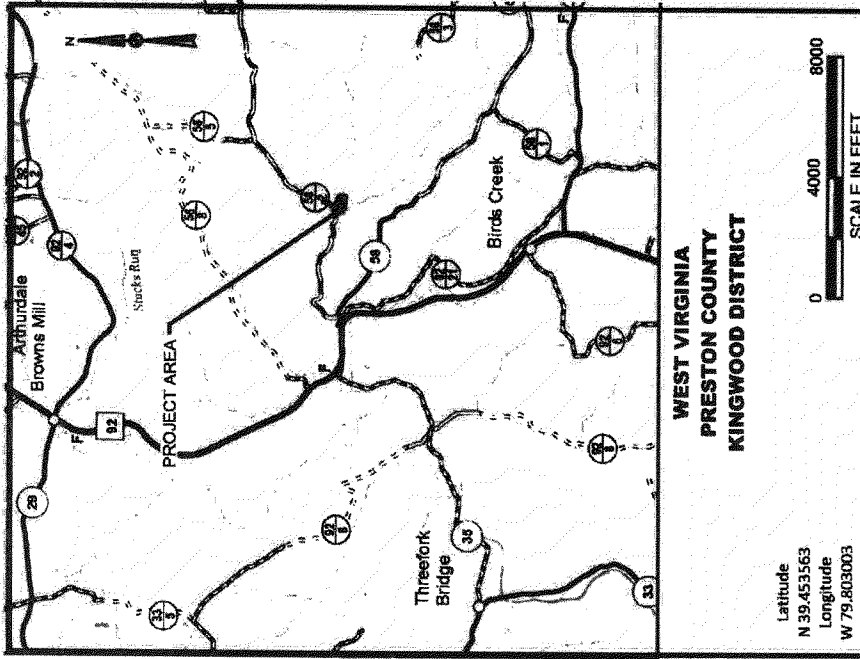
