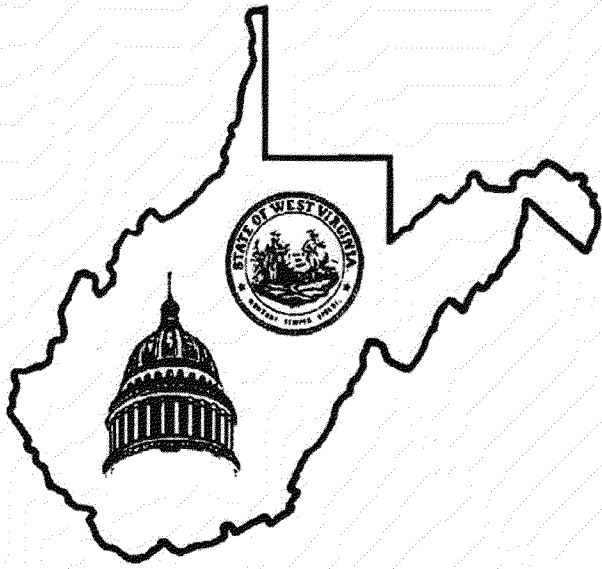

The LVL Rule establishes the regulatory framework necessary for lawful operation of limited video lottery games and ensures compliance with the statutory requirements set forth in the Act.

Each provision of the rule supports the Commissions statutory authority to supervise licensing, regulate gaming operations, and protect the integrity of the Limited Video Lottery program. The amendments clarify qualifications and independence requirements for Commission approved testing laboratories; establish comprehensive background checks for individuals with ownership or influence; require testing facilities to operate securely within the United States; and modernize standards by incorporating nationally accepted benchmarks such as ISO/IEC17025. The amendments also expand evaluation requirements and strengthen the Commissions authority to audit, monitor, and enforce compliance. These provisions collectively ensure fair, reliable, conflict free testing and certification of gaming equipment.

Additionally, the amendments extend the LVL Rules sunset date from August1, 2027, to August 1, 2032, pursuant to W. Va. Code §29A 3 19, providing continued regulatory stability for the program.

II. SECTION-BY-SECTION SUMMARY AND EFFECT

1. Section 4.1 & 4.2 Licensure by Endorsement Categories: This section makes it completely clear that the "licensure by endorsement" pathway applies to all out-of-state applicants, whether they graduated from a traditional CAPTE-accredited program or a non-CAPTE accredited foreign educational program. Statutory Authority: W. Va. Code § 30-20-6 (general rulemaking) and W. Va. Code § 30-20-9 (endorsement licensing rules).

2. Section 4.1.1 & 4.2.1 Direct Transfer of Exam and License Records: This rule updates how applicants prove their exam and disciplinary history. It requires them to have their official NPTE score information (or its successor regulatory record) transferred directly to the Board from the FSBPT. It also requires license verifications from all previous states to prove there are no active investigations or unresolved disciplinary actions. By naming "the FSBPT" rather than a specific website service name, the rule won't break if the vendor rebrands their dashboard. Statutory Authority: W. Va. Code § 30-20-6 (data collection) and W. Va. Code § 30-20-10 (restricting licenses for individuals with out-of-state disciplinary issues).

3. Section 5.5 through 5.6 National Examination Testing Caps & Appeals: This rule incorporates national exam security standards by creating explicit restrictions on NPTE attempts. It enforces an absolute lifetime maximum of six (6) exam attempts at either the PT or PTA level, permanently disqualifies anyone who receives two (2) very low scores (400 or below), and limits applicants to three (3) attempts in a rolling 12-month period. It also establishes that the Board may, at its discretion, sponsor a single eligibility appeal to the FSBPT for an extra attempt due to

Provision: Adjustment of the Biennial Renewal Fee Schedule for Licensed Athletic Trainers: This provision officially modifies the biennial licensing renewal fee schedule for registered and licensed Athletic Trainers within the state, increasing the base fee by \$20.00 from \$80.00 to \$100.00. Due to the alternating nature of the two-year registration cycle, this structural implementation creates a direct financial effect across staggered cohorts. The rule adjustment is projected to generate an additional \$3,500.00 in fiscal year 2027 and \$1,900.00 in fiscal year 2028. This targeted influx yields a cumulative total of \$5,400.00 every 24 months to help counteract an ongoing structural deficit. Empowering Statutory Citation: W. Va. Code §30-20A-2(b)(20)(H), which provides the explicit statutory designation enabling the Board to establish and adjust individual fee requirements by legislative rule.
2. Provision: Administration and Funding Allocation for Shared Board Operating Expenses: This structural provision authorizes the collection and specific application of athletic training revenues to cover essential shared board expenditures. These funds are directed to absorb an impending vendor contract price hike for the online licensure database, which will spike from \$9,700.00 to \$25,000.00 annually in August 2027. Furthermore, it provides the legal mechanism to fund inflation-driven cost increases across general operational categories, including attorney
