

Statement of Waiver

For Candidates, Political Action Committees, or Political Party Executive Committees Exempt From Filing An Annual, First or First General Campaign Finance Report

Candidates and committees who receive and/or spend less than \$500.00 during the annual reporting period or during the first general reporting period do not have to file a financial report. The annual reporting period begins on the last Saturday in March and continues for 15 days. In an election year, the report may be called the "first" report for candidates who plan to run in the primary election. The first general reporting period begins on the last Saturday in September and continues for 15 days.

Candidates who do not have to file a financial report may instead file a Statement of Waiver. This Statement of Waiver tells the public and press that the candidate is not required to file a financial report.

NOTE: THE STATEMENT OF WAIVER CANNOT BE FILED IN PLACE OF ANY PRE-PRIMARY, POST-PRIMARY, PRE-GENERAL, OR POST-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT.

Please check appropriate box to indicate which report you are filing.

First or Annual: Due last Saturday in March or within 15 days thereafter.

First General: Due last Saturday in September or within 15 days thereafter.
